## Proceeding of Research Council Second Meeting

The second Research Council Meeting was held in the Vice Chancellor Secretariat, Agriculture University, Jodhpur on 30.8.2017 under the Chairmanship of Dr. Balraj Singh, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, AU, Jodhpur.

At the outset, Member Secretary of the Council and Director Research, Dr. B. R. Choudhary, welcomed Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Dr. Balraj Singh and all other members of the council. Thereafter, the Vice Chancellor and Chairman of the Council apprised about the progress and major developmental activities carried out and ongoing in the University.

Dr. B. R. Choudhary presented the progress report of 2016-17 of the Directorate of Research. After discussion, the proceeding of first Research Council Meeting was approved by the house.

As per agenda item, Dr. Choudhary presented major research findings of 2016-17 and also about those which were included PoP of different zones. He apprised the house about experimentations conducted on new crops like Quinoa (*Chenopodium quinoa*), Chia (*Salvia hispanica*), Asalia (*Lepidium sativum*) etc.

He also presented progress about seed production of different stations during 2016-17. The house appreciated growth made in seed production including hybrid seed of bajra by the University.

The house discussed at length about research programme to be taken during 2017-18 and approved the same. During presentation, the Secretary also informed house in details about ongoing and newly sanctioned project(s) under RKVY along with financial sanction for year 2017-18.

The member secretary informed the house about execution of non-exclusive MoU between AU, Jodhpur and Wellnext Seeds (India) Pvt. Ltd., New Delhi for seed production of MPMH 17 hybrid Bajra. The house appreciated efforts made by the University.

Director Research informed the house that Phyto-sanitary Lab established at ARS, Mandor, Jodhpur is in running condition. Further he apprised about fees to be charges for various analyses/ test of the samples in the laboratories of the Agriculture University, Jodhpur as suggested by a committee constituted for this purpose. The purposed fee structure is as under:
